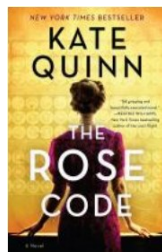

Joining the elite Bletchley Park codebreaking team during World War II, three women from very different walks of life uncover a spy's dangerous agenda.



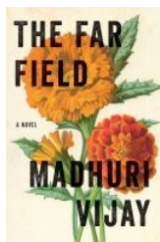
Island Queen

Inspired by true events: Dorothy fights against colonialism in an attempt to buy freedom for herself, her mother, and her sister.



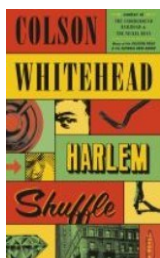
The Far Field

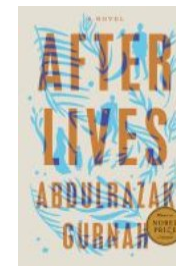
The Night Watchman

Traces the experiences of a Chippewa Council night watchman in mid-19th-century North Dakota who fights Congress to enforce Native American treaty rights.



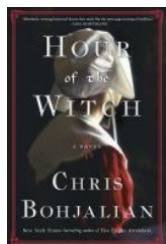
Afterlives

A family saga that starts when a man returns home years after being kidnapped to find his family gone.



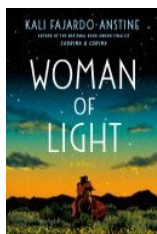
Hour of the Witch

Two women in a 1600s Norwegian village struggle to survive against both natural forces and the men who have been sent to rid the community of witchcraft.



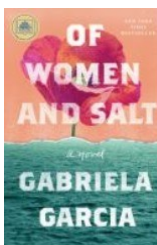

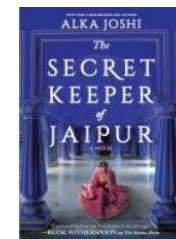
Of Women & Salt

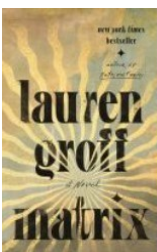

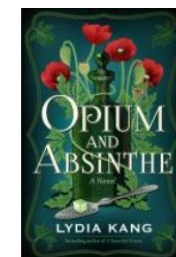

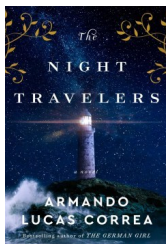
