

### **Celebrating a Wonderful Year!**

We are excited to celebrate our first year in the new library. 2024 has been a remarkable year! Here's a look at some of the highlights from 2024:

Library visits increased 65% to 128,164

Checkout of library items increased 28% with 240,263 checkouts in 2024.

The new library study and meeting rooms were used 3,192 times. Patrons asked more questions. Staff helped with 11,204 reference questions (questions that required staff research) in 2024.

Attendance was 16,849 at the 592 library programs.

The library collection includes 78,218 items for community members to borrow and enjoy.

Community members borrowed 53,870 items from our digital collection, which includes e-audiobooks, e-books, e-video, and e-magazines).
